

Biography

Dr. Tamás T. László was born on March 11, 1964, in Győr, Hungary. He graduated from the Faculty of General Medicine at Semmelweis University in 1990. He obtained board certification in otorhinolaryngology in 1995, audiology in 2015, and earned his Ph.D. in 2019.

Since 1990, Dr. Tamás has been working at the Department of Otorhinolaryngology, Head and Neck Surgery at the Petz Aladár County Teaching Hospital in Győr, where he currently serves as a senior consultant. Building on the legacy of Dr. Emil Hochenburger, he has played a leading role in modernizing the department's otoneurological laboratory into a state-of-the-art diagnostic center for vestibular disorders, in collaboration with his colleagues.

Dr. Tamás is an active member of the Hungarian Society of Oto-Rhino-Laryngology, Head & Neck Surgery, the Neurootological and Equilibriometric Society (NES), and the Society to Improve Diagnosis in Medicine. Since 2016, he has served as secretary of the Otoneurology Section of the Hungarian ENT Society and is set to assume its presidency in 2025.

He has completed international fellowships and study visits in Buffalo, Zürich, Krems, Stockholm, and Sydney. His scientific output includes eight first-author and one senior-author publications, with a total impact factor of 6.307. His 2017 article "*Dizziness assessment in the emergency department: new bedside diagnostic approaches*" was awarded the prestigious Markusovszky Prize by *Orvosi Hetilap*.

Dr. Tamás is a regular speaker at national and international conferences and actively participates in postgraduate medical education. He also organized major dizziness-focused conferences under the title *Vertigyőr* in 2017, 2019, and 2023.
